### **Minnesota's Greatest Generation Film Screens at Saint Paul Public Library**

SAINT PAUL – In honor of Veteran's Day Highland Park Branch Library and Rondo Community Outreach Library are presenting free, public screenings of original, short films that explore the lives and legacy of Minnesota's Greatest Generation in November.

On Wednesday, November 7 at 7 p.m., Highland Park Branch Library will explore Family Ties through two films chronicling the experience of growing up in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century: *The Life and Legacy of Lorraine Bresin* by Sunny Bresin and *One Boy's Story* by Terry Gydesen.

On Tuesday, November 13 at 6 p.m., Rondo Community Outreach Library will reflect on the Holocaust with the films *Sabina Zimering: A Memoir of Courage* by Gwen Briesemeister and *Prisoner 32,232* by Gayle Knutson.

As part of the Greatest Generation Project, representatives from the Minnesota Historical Society will be on hand to talk about the value of preserving family stories and propose ways to share them with others.

Recently produced by film-makers of all ages and abilities, these short films (10 minutes or less) reveal how events at home and abroad affected individuals and created a legacy that still influences us today.
