

eBooks from OverDrive for iPad, iPhone, and iPod Touch

1 – Get Ready

Get a library card.

eBooks from OverDrive can be checked out by anyone with a Twin Cities metro area library card that is registered in the Saint Paul Public Library system.

Download the free OverDrive Media Console app from the App Store.

Authorize your device. (You will only need to do this once.)

In the OverDrive Media Console app, go to Get Books —> Settings —> Authorize with Adobe ID. Select “Register at Adobe.com”.

Follow the instructions to sign up for an Adobe ID.

Return to the OverDrive app and go to Get Books —> Settings —> Authorize with Adobe ID.

Enter the email address and password for your Adobe account.

Tap “Authorize”.

Connect to Saint Paul Public Library.

Go to “Get Books”.

Tap “Add a Library”.

Enter “Saint Paul” and tap “Search”.

Tap “St. Paul Public Library” (Saint Paul, Minnesota, United States)

Tap the star icon to add the library as a favorite source.

2 – Search and Check Out

Find eBooks.

Go to “Get Books”.

Tap “St. Paul Public Library”.

Search and browse for books. Add titles to your cart. Be sure to add Adobe EPUB versions.

Check Out

When you are ready to check out, tap “My Book Cart” and then the “Proceed to Checkout” button. Enter your library card number to log in, if needed.

Choose your lending period (7, 14, or 21 days) for each title and then click the “Confirm Checkout” button.

3 – Download and Read

Click “Download” and your book will be downloaded to your device and be available in the OverDrive app. Tap the title on your “Bookshelf” to start reading.

More

Returning Books

eBooks will automatically be returned at the end of their lending period.

To return an eBook early, delete the title from your “Bookshelf” and choose the “Return then Delete” option.
