

# eBooks from OverDrive for Kindle

## 1 – Get Ready

### Get a library card.

eBooks from OverDrive can be checked out by anyone with a Twin Cities metro area library card that is registered in the Saint Paul Public Library system.

### Register your Kindle or Kindle reading app with your Amazon.com account.

Kindle reading apps are available for most mobile devices and computers.

## 2 – Search and Check Out

### Find eBooks.

Browse and search for Kindle books in the Saint Paul Public Library's eBook collection:  
<http://spl.lib.overdrive.com>

Add titles to your cart. Be sure to add the Kindle version (most, but not all, books in the OverDrive eBook collection are available for Kindle).

### Check out.

Click “My Book Cart” and then the “Proceed to Checkout” button.

Enter your library card number to log in, if needed.

Choose your lending period (7, 14, or 21 days) for each title and then click the “Confirm Checkout” button.

Click the “Get for Kindle” button.

This sends you to the Amazon.com website. Sign in to your Amazon account and send the eBook to your Kindle.

*Note: Certain publishers' titles are not available for wireless delivery. If wireless delivery is not available, download the title and then transfer it to your Kindle using a USB cable.*

## 3 – Download and Read

Your book will be downloaded to your Kindle the next time it connects and syncs.

(Alternatively, you can transfer to Kindle via USB connection. Follow the instructions on the screen and click for details.)

### Returning Books

eBooks will automatically be returned at the end of their lending period.

To return an eBook early, sign in to your Amazon.com account and click “Manage Your Kindle.” Find the book you want to return. Click the “Actions...” button and then click “Return this book.”
