

eBooks from OverDrive for Nook

1 – Get Ready

Get a library card.

eBooks from OverDrive can be checked out by anyone with a Twin Cities metro area library card that is registered in the Saint Paul Public Library system.

Install Adobe Digital Editions.

Go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions> to download Adobe Digital Editions for your computer.

Authorize your computer with an Adobe ID. (You will only need to do this once.)

If your Nook is already registered to make purchases at Barnes & Noble, your device is already authorized, and you should use the same email address and password to authorize Adobe Digital Editions on your computer.

If you do not already have an Adobe ID, click “Get an Adobe ID online” and follow the instructions to sign up.

Return to the Activation screen (you can find it under the Library view of Adobe Digital Editions by going to Library —> Authorize Computer).

Authorize your Nook (if needed).

When you plug your Nook into your computer, Adobe Digital Editions may ask to authorize the device. Once the Nook is authorized, eBooks from OverDrive may be transferred to it.

Your Nook and Adobe Digital Editions need to be authorized with the same Adobe ID.

2 – Search and Check Out

Find eBooks.

Browse and search for books in the Saint Paul Public Library’s eBook collection:
<http://sppl.lib.overdrive.com>

Add titles to your cart. Be sure to add the EPUB or PDF version (EPUB is recommended for most titles).

Checkout.

Click “My Book Cart” and then the “Proceed to Checkout” button.

Enter your library card number to log in, if needed.

Choose your lending period (7, 14, or 21 days) for each title and then click the “Confirm Checkout” button.

Click the “Download” button.

3 – Download and Read

Your book will be downloaded and open in Adobe Digital Editions. The book can be read on your computer and/or transferred to your Nook.

To transfer to your Nook, plug the Nook into your computer.

The Nook will show up on the left side of the screen under “Bookshelves” in the Library view of Adobe Digital Editions.

Click and drag book covers to the icon for the Nook.

eBooks from OverDrive cannot be downloaded using library computers.

Returning Books

eBooks will automatically be returned at the end of their lending period.

To return an eBook early, open Adobe Digital Editions and go to the Library view. Hover over the book cover for the eBook you want to return, click the Item Options arrow that appears in the upper left corner, and then choose “Return Borrowed Item”.

EPUB vs. PDF

EPUB eBooks feature reflowable text, which means you can resize the text or change the size of your display and the text reflows to fill the available view area.

PDF eBooks feature a static layout with set page breaks. PDF works well for graphic novels, illustrated titles, and other titles with specific formatting.
